

Job Description: INSPECTOR (MOSQUITO CONTROL)

CLASS NO. 2407

SUMMARY OF POSITION

Inspects rice fields and marsh sites for mosquito activity; performs public health pest control as needed; performs structural pest control operations; and maintains pumphouses at county facilities.

ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS

1. Reports to: General Foreman and PM Crew Coordinator
2. Directs: This is a non-supervisory position.
3. Other: Has contact with ranchers, farmers, local community organizations, other county employees, and the public.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Essential Duties*

Performs public health pest control;

Performs structural pest control in county structures for non-wood destroying pests;

Conducts various surveillance and monitoring procedures by land and water in designated areas, such as marshes, ditches and rice fields for mosquito populations; including collecting rainfall data;

Collects and identifies adult and larval mosquitoes;

Maintains county-owned water systems;

Assists in maintaining equipment and grounds, including performing routine and preventive maintenance on trucks, motors, light traps, and pumps, preparing vehicles and spray equipment for treatment operations, and cleaning shop.

Other Important Duties*

Performs such other related duties as may be assigned.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of: public health pest control procedures and techniques; structural pest control procedures and techniques; surveillance and monitoring procedures; and mosquito collection (adult and larval) sampling techniques.

Skill/Ability to: safely handle hazardous chemicals; understand and follow instructions; establish and maintain effective working relationships with other county employees and the general public; compile, analyze, interpret and read data; tolerate outside working condition, including exposure to adverse weather conditions; be prepared to work weekends, holidays, and awkward hours depending on mosquito activity and scheduled treatment times; and maintain required certifications, Texas driver's license applicable to job responsibilities, and good driving record.

ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

High school graduation or its equivalent, and at least one year of related experience;

Alternatively, any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities.
