

Job Description: SIGN WORKER (ROAD & BRIDGE)

SUMMARY OF POSITION

Performs tasks associated with road sign preparation, installation, removal, and repair.

ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS

1. Reports to: Sign Foreman
2. Directs: This is a non-supervisory position.
3. Other: Has daily contact with co-workers.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Essential Duties*

Makes road signs for the road and bridge department which includes cutting masking film and using tufback and silkscreening techniques to ensure highly visible finished products;

Installs accurately positioned and readily visible road signs in designated locations as directed;

Removes damaged or obsolete road signs from roadsides, bridges, medians, etc., as required;

Makes necessary repairs to damaged road signs as necessary; and

Prepares graphic layouts for road signs.

Other Important Duties*

Performs such other related duties as may be assigned.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of: sign painting methods and techniques.

Skill/Ability to: understand and follow instructions; effectively use reflective tapes, paintbrushes, spray guns, razor knives, and various hand tools, etc., to prepare highly visible road signs, tolerate outside working conditions, including exposure to adverse weather conditions; establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers.
