

Job Description: MAINTENANCE WORKER (ROAD & BRIDGE)

CLASS NO. 2130

EEOC CATEGORY: Service-Maintenance

SUMMARY OF POSITION

Performs tasks associated with and assists in the construction of county roads and bridges. Duties include operating road construction equipment and tools, patching potholes, preparing road bases, transporting materials, and clearing brush and trash from roadsides.

ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS

1. Reports to: Foreman (Road and Bridge)
2. Directs: This is a non-supervisory position.
3. Other: Has daily contact with co-workers.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Essential Duties*

Operates road construction equipment including pickup trucks, dump trucks, front-end loaders, rubber tire rollers, tractors, rotary brooms, post drivers, and spreader boxes;

Operates various hand and power tools, including chainsaws, shovels, sledgehammers, mowers, air tamps, and jackhammers;

Assists in the construction and maintenance of county roads and bridges, including setting up barricades at work sites to warn traffic of hazardous areas, preparing road base, and measuring, cleaning, and filling potholes;

Hand shovels dirt, gravel, or asphalt;

Tamps, packs, and levels dirt, asphalt, or other material;

Trims trees and brush, mows grass, picks up brush and trash, and loads onto truck;

Loads and unloads road construction and repair materials using front-end loader for transport to job sites;

Sets up water pumps for use in road construction projects; and

Constructs and/or repairs roadside fences as directed.

Other Important Duties*

Performs such other related duties as may be assigned.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of: methods, equipment, and materials used in the construction and maintenance and bridges; and the safe operation of equipment used and the provisions of the Texas Motor Vehicle Code relating to operation of motorized equipment.

Skill/Ability to: understand and follow instructions; learn to use power and/or hand-operated tools; tolerate outside working conditions, including exposure to adverse weather conditions; establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers; and maintain Texas driver's license applicable to job responsibilities and good driving record.

ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

Sufficient education to understand, interpret, and follow instructions;

or any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities.

Appropriate Texas driver's license.
