Safely operate power equipment including, but not limited to, industrial forklifts, man lifts, skid steer loaders, and other mobile equipment; or to ferry vehicles and equipment to and from workshop; and

Ability to operate scale which is utilized in calculating incoming waste stream;

Ability to identify and classify various waste streams so as to insure safe plant operations.

Performs general welding fabrication and repair on roll off containers and department equipment as directed;

Operates welding machines, sandblast and paint equipment as directed, hand and bench grinders, cutting torches, related safety equipment in performing welding repair and fabrication tasks, sandblast and paint equipment; and

Maintain clean and well organized welding shop to ensure safe and efficient working conditions.

Other Important Duties*

Performs such other related duties as may be assigned.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of: Safety awareness to prevent severe damage to equipment or injury to personnel; standards and precautions applicable to equipment repair;

Effectively communicate with other personnel via in-situ intercom system and two-way radio;

Receive and comprehend instructions, given both written and verbally; also the ability to perform tasks or functions completely with minimal supervision;

Perform frequent independent decisions to ensure safe and proper operation and maintenance;

Perform a wide variety of mechanical repairs on many types of vehicles and equipment;

Recognize operational inconsistencies and hazards in the workplace and display proper judgement in responding to them; also reporting them to the supervisor;

Access confined space and pressure vessels thru standard 12" x 16" man ways;

Work in confined spaces and vessel that have minimal head room and work spaces for the purpose of performing inspections and repairs on a routine basis;

Plate welding and welding fabrication practices and techniques; and the safe use of welding equipment;

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Work in areas under adverse conditions that may require the donning and use of personal protective equipment including, but not limited to, the following with average fatigue;

- TYVEK suit
- Hardhat
- Approved safety shoes
- Eye protection (corrective or otherwise)
- Rubber suit and gloves
- Chemical resistant suit
- Approved hearing protection
- Work boots and gloves

Perform moderate to heavy lifting in a safe and efficient manner; and

Skill/Ability to: perform welding, sandblasting and painting tasks as directed; safely and effectively operate hand and bench grinders, welding machines, and cutting torches; tolerate outside working conditions including exposure to adverse weather conditions; understand and follow instructions; and establish and maintain effective working relationship with co-workers.

ACCEPTABLE EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING

High school graduation or its equivalent, plus at least two (2) years experience in general, industrial and heavy equipment repair; *Or* any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities.

CERTIFICATIONS AND LICENSES REQUIRED

TDL, Pre-employment physical/drug testing required. Appropriate Texas driver's license.

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
