

Job Description: ROLL OFF TRUCK DRIVER
(SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT)

SUMMARY OF POSITION

Operates assigned equipment, including roll-off truck, to empty dumpsters and transport the contents to the county landfill; replaces damaged dumpsters; performs routine and preventive maintenance on vehicles; and assists the general public at community collection stations.

ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS

1. Reports to: Collection Station Supervisor.
2. Directs: This is a non-supervisory position.
3. Other: Has regular contact with co-workers and the general public.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Essential Duties*

Operates assigned equipment safely, including roll-off collection truck and transports the contents to county landfill;

Operates roll-off trucks to pick up garbage and out-of-service appliances, such as stoves and washing machines, from various collection stations around the county and transports items to county landfill;

Removes and replaces damaged dumpsters from collection stations;

Performs routine and preventive maintenance on vehicles, including checking oil and fluid levels, refueling, fixing flat tires, etc.; and

Assist the general public at community collection stations with solid waste disposal tasks as necessary.

Other Important Duties*

Performs such other related duties as may be assigned.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of: the provisions of the Texas Motor Vehicle Code pertaining to the safe operation of assigned equipment.

Skill/Ability to: safely operate roll-off collection truck; understand and follow instructions; tolerate outside working conditions, including exposure to adverse weather conditions; perform routine and preventive maintenance on assigned equipment; establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers and the general public; and maintain Texas driver's license applicable to job responsibilities and good driving record.

ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

Sufficient education to understand, interpret, and follow instructions, plus one (1) year of experience operating light equipment.

Or any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities.

CERTIFICATES AND LICENSES REQUIRED

Appropriate Texas driver's license.
