SUMMARY OF POSITION

Operates various types of equipment engaged in the construction, repair or maintenance at the County Landfill and Citizen Collection Stations.

ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS

1. Reports to: Landfill Supervisor
2. Directs: This is a non-supervisory position
3. Other: Has daily contact with other solid waste department employees

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Essential Duties*

Performs general equipment maintenance and repair tasks;

Removes brush, debris and litter from roadside ditches;

Performs routine and preventative maintenance on vehicles, including checking oil and fluid levels, refueling, fixing flat tires, etc.;

Operates magnet truck to collect assorted metal scrap, collect used oil filters, and perform various maintenance projects as directed;

Assists the general public at citizen collection stations with solid waste disposal tasks, as necessary;

Other Important Duties*

Performs such other related duties as may be assigned.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of: the safe operation of the equipment.

Skill/Ability to: understand and follow instructions; service and minor repairs on equipment applying safety standards to prevent hazards; tolerate outside working conditions, including exposure to adverse weather conditions; establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers; and maintain Texas driver's license applicable to job responsibilities and good driving record.

ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

High school graduation, or its equivalent, plus at least two years of experience as an equipment operator, including experience operating heavy equipment;

Or any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities.

CERTIFICATES AND LICENSES REQUIRED

Appropriate Texas driver's license.
